- Be recognized and valued by the Ontario alpine ski community for what we deliver as an organization



#### Findings

- Major issue across all sports
- FIS age change + increasing education pressure on grade 11
- Branding
- Perceived Lack of Clarity and options in Pathway

#### Recommendations

- Research the Broader Issue and Strategies
- More Research to find out why athletes are leaving our sport?
- Consistent and Transparent Policies and Procedures
- Athlete Education Opportunities
- Coach Education
- Promote Ski Racing



# Committee Findings and Recommendations: Pathways and Programming

#### Findings

- Retention affects performance (Obviously!)
- Athletes are leaving the province at U18 to continue racing
- Disjointed/Gap (U16 HP team, no U18 HP, Ontario Ski Team)
- Programs are small and serve multiple rolls
- Geography and Cost

#### Recommendations

- More Consistency in Pathway U16-U18-U21.
  High Performance & Development/Participation
- Bolster U18 level
- Long Term Development Strategy
- Improve sport and fitness culture
- Coaches Education Club Excellence
