Registering your athlete for FIS

Registration for Ontario FIS racers is now open. If your club is not showing on our registration page and you need to register, please email communications@alpineontario.ca. To be eligible for FIS competitions, Ontario racers are required to purchase a FIS card along with your Alpine Ontario and Alpine Canada membership on the Snowreg registration system found here.

There are several requirements to be eligible for FIS competition including medical evaluation, FIS Declaration form, and mandatory Sport Accident Insurance. Sport Accident Insurance packages will vary depending on whether you are racing in Canada, or Internationally. For more information on these requirements and on selecting sport accident insurance (SAIP), click here.

New "International FIS Athlete Service Fee"

Alpine Canada Alpine has introduced a new fee for athletes who are participating in an

Examples of programs that Canadian athletes participate in outside of Canada include (but are not limited to):

- USA Academies (Burke Mtn, GMVS etc.),
- USA Universities and Colleges (Dartmouth, UVM, Plymouth etc.)
- USA Clubs (Steamboat, Vail, Palisades / Tahoe etc.)
- International club or academy programs (ISRA, LIT, Orsatus, Apex2100 etc.)

In order to provide the service required to support these athletes while residing and competing outside of Canada, an annual fee of \$150.00 CAD is now applicable.
