



AOA Event Sanction Application 2024-25

AOA is committed to the growth and development of ski racing throughout the province.

Ensuring clubs have opportunities to promote their programs to the membership as well as provide the necessary insurance coverage for all participants remains a high priority for the organization.

AOA will continue to make available event insurance for all our sanctioned clubs who wish to host additional supplemental events to ensure the appropriate coverage is made available for all competitors.

What are the submission guidelines?

Please submit the attached application detailing the following areas:

- **Athletic merit** - How does the proposed event fit with the AOA program guidelines and LTSD/LTAD.
- **Skill Development** - What additional skills development opportunities are being presented? i.e. set up Skill Stations for athletes to participate while waiting for their start.
- **Target group** – what is the qualification process or is the event open?
- **Registration** – what is the process for registration?
- **Competitive Focus** – What is the focus of your event? Give us details on how the event will run and level of competitive focus.
- **Coach education** - Are there coach education components to the project, e.g. Speed module, mentorship.
- **List of Qualified Officials responsible for the event** – Who is the ROC? What are their official's levels?
- **Venue Information** - Where are you hosting the event? Is this a homologated venue? Who is the program head coach?
- **Safety Protocol** – (EAP) What is your safety plan for the event?

Benefits of sanction

- 1) Codex creation and use of www.alpinepoints.ca for race entries.
- 2) Use of AOA platforms for promotion of events, inclusion on the AOA calendar including posting of race notice.



- 3) Use of the ACA official's pool for race execution. Upon request AOA will facilitate the assignment of an AOA TD.
- 4) Race support from AOA/SOD – operational support - bibs (if available), race administrative and technical support.
- 5) Insurance coverage for all athletes, officials, coaches and primary liability coverage for host club. Without AOA's sanction, officials, coaches and visiting athlete's claims will not be valid against ACA insurance policies, thus putting the host club at increased exposure.

**Please note that conflicting event sponsors cannot be included on the event race notice or the AOA platforms.
