Mackenzie Financial Women In Ski Racing – "Level Up" Project

AOA will be contacting each club to review their coach evaluator needs and plans for moving coaches from trained to certified this season and identifying coaches for evaluation EL/DL/PL



TRANSGENDER & NONBINARY



FIS International Events - All FIS events (including FIS children's events such as Whistler Cup, Scara, etc.)

Categories Male and Female Classification based on Sex at Birth



National level events (National competitive card) - We do not have clarity at this time. PSO/ACA Working group with the support of Transinclusion consultant completed a Transgender & Nonbinary Inclusion policy. Policy is under review with ACA board of directors. We do not expect it to be in place for 2024/25. Those affected should contact AOA for guidance.



Recreational level competition (Rec. Card) - In ontario this is U12 and younger - Athletes register on Snowreg in the gender in which they identify with. The focus is on ensuring participation and valuing inclusion.

FAQ: What if parents get upset?

- Underscore Alpine Canada's value of inclusion
- Focus on ensuring participation
- Explain policy is needed to address unique issues of trans & non-binary athletes, which are 0.33% of pop'l
- Explain physical features vary widely irrespective of gender



FAQ: What if participants on another team ask?

- Important to maintain athlete privacy
- No need to "explain" someone's gender
- Simple response: "This athlete is in the right category"
- Explain broadly: Cannot know someone's gender identity based on appearance or anatomy
