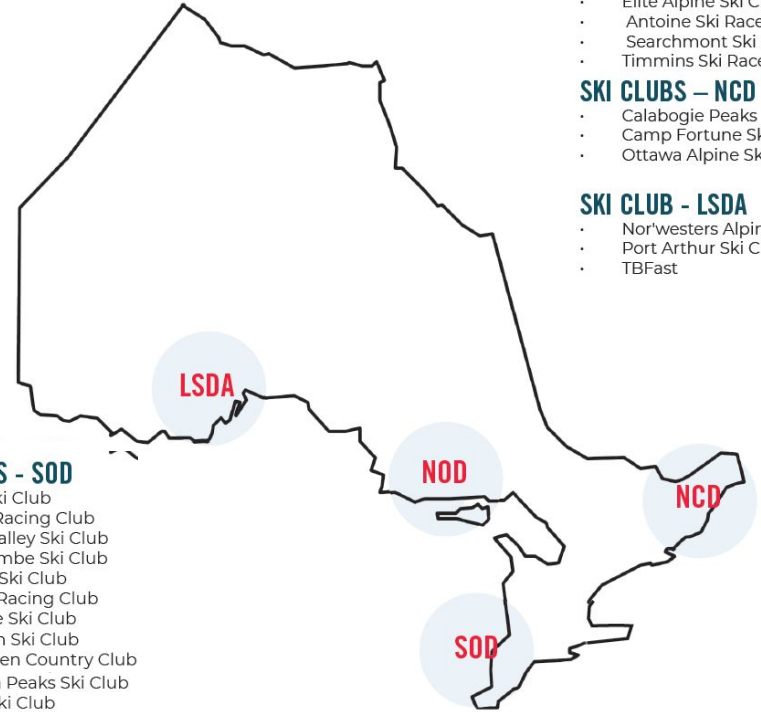

COACH EDUCATION UPDATE

Be a Canada Ski Coach Member and Licensed!

AOA to emphasize the importance by adding the following to new race notices for AOA events

Coach Requirements - Coaches *must*:

- have a current coach membership with ACA-CSC (Canada Ski Coaches) in snowreg
- be a licensed ACA-CSC coach (snowreg/ NCCP locker)
- be present with athletes on-site
- be able to show up-to-date snowreg/ NCCP/ official's requirements for the level of athlete participation to gain access to the training/ racing environment (field of play).

It is the club's and coach's responsibility to ensure they have the correct certifications and coaching license for competition.

The idea is that coaches should feel confident that those in the field of play with them have the credentials to be there.

This will be expanded to include certification levels depending on event and future verification at events. Send your feedback to Sarah.
