The Ontario Ski Team women have been hard at work preparing for the season ahead. After completing six productive days of indoor training this summer, the team spent 15 days in Chile at El Colorado and followed that with 12 challenging days on snow in Austria.

Next up, the athletes are heading north to Mount Sima in the Yukon for their final pre-season camp. The focus will be on fine-tuning routines, sharpening warm-ups, and executing strategic course

ONTARIO SKI TEAM MEN

The Ontario Ski Team has had a productive and exciting start to the season, with athletes putting in valuable miles on snow and continuing to build momentum toward race season.

We kicked things off in Chile, where athletes took advantage of excellent early-summer conditions for a high-volume training block focused on fundamentals and technical consistency. From there, the team headed to Germany for a productive European camp, training alongside top international skiers and getting valuable time on challenging surfaces that pushed technical precision and adaptability.

Now, the team is gearing up for the final prep block out west, as we head to Colorado for on-snow training ahead of the first NorAm races in Beaver Creek. Spirits are high, and the athletes are eager to test themselves against the continent's best.

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We are pleased to welcome **Ellen Rowe** to the OPASt roster this season, joining team alumni **James Budrow** and **Jessica McPhee*** as we head into a full winter schedule.

The team will kick off the season with a small project at **Searchmont** in late November, with a greater focus on remaining local to Ontario until we head west to prepare for the main competition phase.

A key benefit of staying local early in the season is the opportunity to **create on-snow coaching interface sessions** — providing interested coaches with valuable experience working alongside high-level Para athletes.

From February through March, OPASt will be based in Western Canada, attending both the **CADS Festival** and the **CAN Nationals pre-camp and race series**.

During this period, OPASt will host a **“Ski Up” Mega Camp (March 15–22)** for candidate athletes. This camp will provide valuable race training exposure — and serve as an excellent lead-in to the technical events at Nationals for the right athletes.

As in past seasons, OPASt will wrap up the year with a five-day camp following CAN Nationals. This project will focus on initiating the technical changes planned for the **2026–27 season** and will also serve as a great opportunity for any interested athletes or coaches to get involved.— **Nick Kwasniak, OPASt Head Coach**

From Grassroots to World-Cup

The SOD Ski Cross Committee has been hard at work throughout the off-season, preparing for an exciting year of cross events, clinics, and training opportunities. We're thrilled to announce that the **FIS World Cup** will be returning to **Craighleith, March 19–22**, following the tremendous success of last season's event. A huge thank-you goes out to Craighleith and the many volunteers who make hosting a World Cup possible—these events are a major undertaking and a point of pride for our province.

At the grassroots level, SOD is planning to host **four provincial ski cross events** this season, scheduled to allow maximum participation from **U12 Development** and **SCUP** athletes. We're encouraged by the continued support and integration of ski cross we're seeing across our regional clubs—it's clear that more coaches and athletes are recognizing how cross contributes to skill development for all racers, not just those specializing in the discipline.

The Ski Cross Committee is also developing **new educational video assets** to highlight the benefits

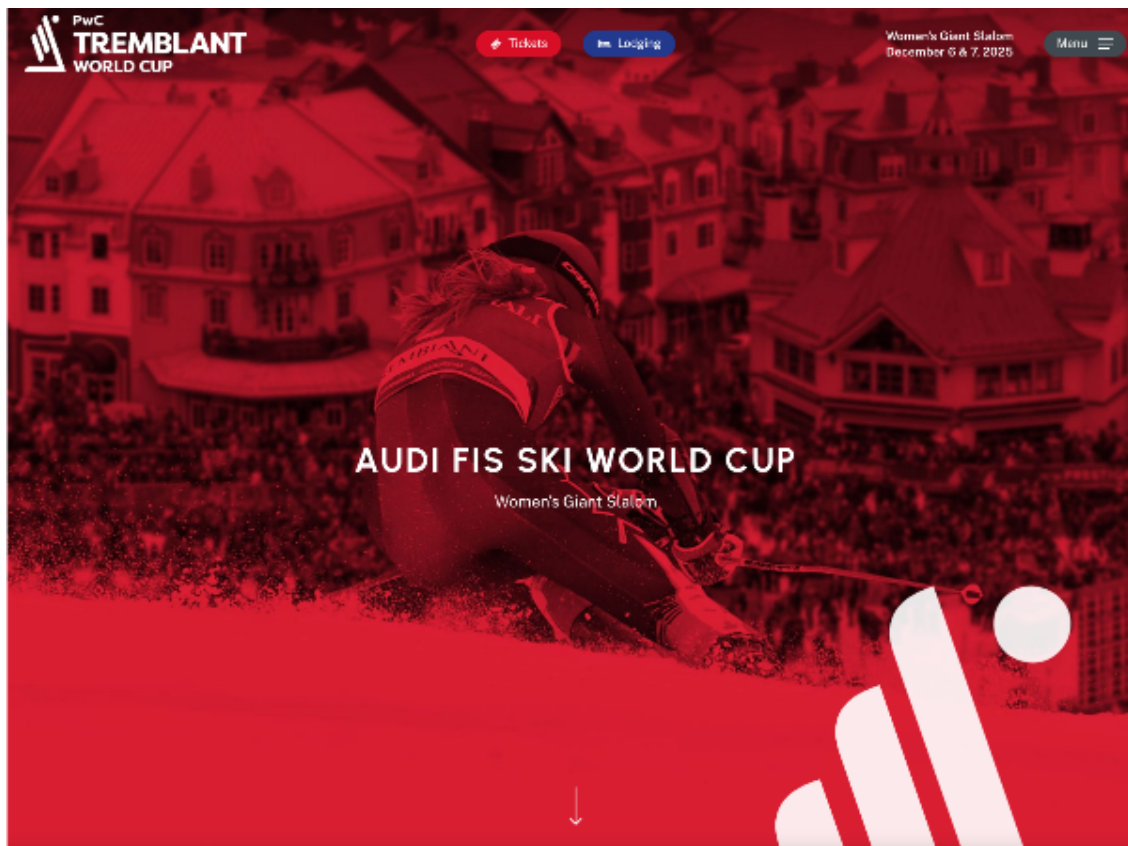
