SUBJECT: Release of the Concussion Management Tracking Tool

Dear Sport Sector Partners,

I'm pleased to share a new Concussion Management Tracking Tool designed to help ensure that all sport organizations with participating athletes are aware of the athlete's current concussion management status. The tool can be found alongside Ontario's suite of concussion resources [at this link](#).

A digital or printed version of the tool can be voluntarily shared by an athlete or their parent or guardian with the athlete's school sport or community sport organization(s) as they progress through the return to school and/or return to sport steps.

The Ministry encourages athletes or their parents/guardians to voluntarily share the tool, outlining the athlete's concussion status, with organizations across various sport environments and teams.

The contents of this tool are based on expert concussion management guidance from Parachute's 2nd edition Canadian Guidelines for Concussion in Sport, which is the same guidance that informs all other concussion-related materials on the Government of Ontario's concussion portal webpages.

I ask that each of you please share this tool across your organizations to help facilitate its voluntary use by athletes or their parents/guardians to support concussion management. Sharing an athlete's concussion management status across the school and sport settings through the assistance of resources like the Concussion Management Tracking Tool is one of the many ways we can collectively help make sport safer for Ontario's athletes.
